Do you ever wonder how our neighborhood is ranked for being a great place to live? I did some research and found this:

"Hill Valley is a neighborhood in Indianapolis, Indiana with a population of 8,484. Hill Valley is in Marion County and is one of the best places to live in Indiana. Living in Hill Valley offers residents a dense suburban feel and most residents own their homes. Many young professionals and retirees live in Hill Valley and residents tend to lean conservative. The public schools in Hill Valley are highly rated."

There were multiple articles found that basically said the same thing: "Hill Valley Estates is ranked amongst the top in the state to live and raise a family in."

After I read this article, it compelled me to share this with all my fellow neighbors. We should all feel proud and blessed to be living in such a highly rated area, and we should feel a sense of satisfaction. We are an older neighborhood compared to others but we still only charge a small amount of \$45 per YEAR for dues in order to maintain the two beautiful entrances to our neighborhood, snow plowing, and an included ticket to our annual picnic!

I'm not sure that many of you are aware that all these new and upcoming neighborhoods have MANDATORY dues that vary in price from \$100 to \$500 per MONTH. That is INSANE! Look how fortunate we all are to live in a neighborhood that does not charge that extremely high amount. I simply ask that you rethink this and please join our association today if you haven't already for the very low cost of \$45 per year. I don't know about you but I'm feeling very blessed and grateful to live in Hill Valley Estates.

### WILDLIFE IN HILL VALLEY

During the reconstruction of the County Line Road, the right-of-way clearing began with the felling of the trees. As a result, the wildlife that called that area home are looking for new homes and many are looking in the Hill Valley area to settle. We are seeing raccoons, opossums, foxes, coyotes, hawks, and even a bald eagle has been reported. If you have small to medium size pets or small children, they may not be safe if left alone outside. Coyotes have been common even before the construction process. Please be diligent and keep a close watch on your children and pets.

#### FRIENDLY WARNING

Keep a front and back light on at night on your house. The back side of most homes is pitch dark at night, which invites burglars and home invaders. Parking unlocked cars outside at night is an open invitation for thieves since the thieves strike during the darkness.

Be sure you have locked all of your vehicles before going in for the night. The cost of burning two light bulbs all night is not a great cost compared to losing valuable possessions, especially if you use LED bulbs.
